Okay... here's the top-ten list which actually has 12 psalms on it... because I consider Psalms 1 and 2 to be an introduction to the whole Psalter. The themes and images in Pss 1 and 2 are like the handlebars and brakes on a bike... you can ride without them, but it's tricky and slow going, so being familiar with those two psalms is important. So, here's my top-ten list of twelve psalms:

Intro: **Pss 1-2** (Blessed)

Ps 5 (Morning prayer)

Ps 27 (Fear and beauty)

Ps 32 (Forgiveness and freedom)

Ps 34 (Taste and see)

Ps 42 (Soul thirst)

Ps 62 (Rest in God)

Ps 95 (Worship)

Ps 103 (Compassion in action)

Ps 130 (Wait and hope)

Ps 145 (Everlasting kingdom)

There are so many great Psalms that did not make this list, including the most popular (and likely the most prayed!)... Psalm 23. But if this list helps you get started with praying them... perfect!
